Olga Taussky-Todd (1906–1995) was one of the most famous and versatile female mathematicians of the 20th century. She received her doctorate in the field of number theory from the University of Vienna and was one of the first women to join the Vienna Circle before moving to the University of Göttingen. In 1934, Taussky was forced to emigrate from the German Reich because of her Jewish heritage. Her contributions to the fields of linear algebra, matrix theory, numerical analysis and algebraic number theory are widely regarded as outstanding.

a 3 semester long career development program for female* predocs of the University of Vienna. It combines the three formats mentoring, group coaching and training.

Mentoring: Professors of the University of Vienna serve as mentors regarding scientific careers for small groups of mentees across disciplines.
